<u>Miss Kara</u>

Miss Kara read a story about Narwhal. She reviewed what a growth mindset is- believing in yourself and thinking you can do anything you set your mind to. She explained what a fixed mindset is-thinking things will never get better or easier, no matter how hard you try. The fixed mindset is more discouraging and just gives up. Students gave examples of times where they had a fixed mindset. Miss Kara then looked for examples of when Narwhal used a growth mindset in the story.

What Are We Learning?

Letter Bootcamp- We will be reviewing all letter sounds, sounding out words, and segmenting and blending words.
